COVID-19 Policy

The York Motorcycle Festival is committed to providing a safe environment for patrons to visit and participate in.

In light of the COVID-19 pandemic we are working with Shire of York and local / state health departments to provide a safe as is practicable environment for patrons at the Festival.

The York Motorcycle Festival's COVID-19 Policy serves to adhere to the guidelines surrounding:

- 1. Hygiene
- 2. Contact Tracing
- 3. Physical distancing

The York Motorcycle Festival appreciates your assistance in following policy guidelines to ensure a COVID-Safe event. Please be advised that this Policy is subject to change in accordance with State and Federal government guidelines.

What you can expect when you visit the York Motorcycle Festival.

Before the Festival:

- Visitors will now be asked to download a free ticket from the Festival website.
- When registering for tickets, visitors will be required to include their contact details for Covid tracing purposes.
- Contact tracing information will be kept on a protected file within a show database and only released to the
 appropriate authorities if a case of COVID-19 is reported from the show. This information will not be shared with
 any additional unauthorised third parties. Please refer to Premiere Events' Privacy Policy for further information
 on collection, storage and releasing of personal data.
- Tickets will be required for Adults only. It will be assumed adults attending the event will take responsibility for any children they have with them.

Arriving at the Festival:

- The Festival will now feature Four (4) entry points located as follows:
 - 1. Avon Terrace near the York Town Hall
 - 2. Avon Terrace outside the IGA
 - 3. South Street near the Castle Hotel
 - 4. Walkway between Settlers Hotel and Avon Terrace
- Visitors will be asked to enter the Festival via these entry points and have their tickets scanned by staff.
- Entry points will have signs featuring QR code for the SAFEWA app.
- Visitors will be expected to scan the code on their SAFE WA app prior to entering the Festival area.
- Staff will be available to register names and contact details of visitors who do not have the app.
- Patrons are encouraged to adhere to physical distancing guidelines if queuing, and event staff will remind patrons of this.
- Staffing at the entry points will assist with the flow of people through the entries.
- Staff members are working under guidance from Festival management so please show respect whilst they do their job.
- At all times, visitors are advised that if you are not feeling well to please stay at home.

During your visit:

- Patrons are encouraged to physical distance during their visit to the show, keeping within the 1.5m distancing guidelines.
- Cleaning staff on site to have been increased and will be working throughout the entire Show times to ensure that "touch points" are cleaned frequently.
- Hand sanitiser will be available at entrances/exits.
- On site toilets will have soap available at all times.
- Some activities around the show may have restrictions on the number of people who can watch at one time. Signage will be in these areas to advise patrons.
- Some exhibitors may have limits on the number of people on their stand at any one time.
- Food areas will be spread over larger distances to allow for physical distancing practices.
- Be advised that some exhibitors and food outlets may only take contactless payments.
- If you are not feeling well while you are at the show, please speak to St John's First Aid officers immediately.
